PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

The Parish Council met on 9th October. There were three expressions of interest in the two councillor vacancies. The applicants were considered for each individual vacancy. Isabelle James and Michael Procter were co-opted onto the Parish Council.

The limited assurance review of the Annual Governance & Accountability Return (AGAR) for Great Cransley Parish Council for the year ended 31st March 2025 has now been completed. The notice of completion of audit has now been published, along with the external audit report.

Dog fouling continues to be a problem, which has resulted in the proposed purchase of a further litter bin for Bridle Way.

NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Regulation 16 is a stage in the neighbourhood planning process, where a draft neighbourhood plan is submitted to the local planning authority for public consultation.

This stage ensures that local communities have the opportunity to review and comment on the plan before it is examined by an independent examiner.
